DIRECTIONS TO VENUE

From Junction 17 of the M4 Motorway take the B4122, at the next junction turn left on to the B4069 towards Sutton Benger. In Sutton Benger turn left in front of the Church which is opposite 'The Bell' Hotel. Take this country route for about 4 miles, go through the village of Great Somerford and the Show Ground is on the left hand side just over the river as you leave the village.

From Swindon and M4 Junction 16 take the Royal Wootton Bassett road and at the second roundabout take the B4042 signposted for Brinkworth and Malmesbury; follow the signs for the Somerfords and once in Little Somerford proceed to Great Somerford and after $\frac{3}{4}$ mile the Show Ground will be on your right just before the river.
